

Non-disclosure agreement for volunteers in the Norwegian Red Cross

Adopted by the National Governing Board 13.09.2019, last updated 19.02.21

I hereby undertake not to use, disclose or otherwise make available to any unauthorized party information about personal data or business knowledge or information that I have become aware of during my involvement in the Norwegian Red Cross.

Confidentiality also applies after the involvement as a volunteer in the Norwegian Red Cross has ended. In some special cases, one can or shall be exempted from preserving confidentiality.

This applies to, for example:

- a. when the person entitled to have its information treated confidentially agrees to waiving this obligation
- b. when a person is obliged by national law to disclose otherwise confidential information
- c. when the volunteer becomes aware that a child is exposed to neglect or abuse
- d. when a volunteer, participant or employee is subjected to a criminal act in connection with a Red Cross activity

Further details on the duty of confidentiality and the exceptions to this can be found in a separate guide.

I confirm that I have understood the content of the duty of confidentiality and that at breach of this duty may lead to the exclusion from an activity under the Regulations of the Norwegian Red Cross. Relevant to positions of trust in the Red Cross, a breach of the duty of confidentiality may lead to suspension.

I will also take great care in discussing the Red Cross activities that I have become aware of or experienced as a volunteer in the Norwegian Red Cross.
